### DUTIES

Under general supervision, serves as a company or station commander and performs assigned duties in fire prevention and suppression, emergency medical services, hazardous materials and first responder services. Works within prescribed standards and procedures with some leeway for discretion and independent action.

### REQUIREMENTS (Minimum Qualifications)

The following requirements must be met in order to be considered for employment.

- High School Diploma or G.E.D.;
- No felony convictions;
- No serious misdemeanor convictions for the past five years;
- Excellent physical condition

Candidates must submit copies of supporting documentation that applicant possesses the following qualifications: No further certifications or resume required at this time.

- Valid Missouri Driver's License (within 6 months of employment offer)
- Firefighter I & II
- First Responder (EMT-B if hired after July 1, 2019)
- Driver/Operator (pre-2016) or current Core and Pumper
- Fire Officer I
- 5 years full-time experience (volunteer exp. 3:1 ratio)
