DUTIES

Performs firefighting, fire prevention, emergency medical services and rescue work; maintains and cleans Fire District buildings, grounds, and equipment.

REQUIREMENTS (Minimum Qualifications)

The following requirements must be met in order to be considered for employment.

- Age 18 or older;
- High School Diploma or G.E.D.;
- No felony convictions;
- No serious misdemeanor convictions for the past five years;
- Excellent physical condition

Candidates must submit copies of supporting documentation that applicant possesses the following qualifications: No further certifications or resume required at this time.

- Valid Missouri Driver's License (within 6 months of employment offer)
- First Responder
- Firefighter I & II
