## BALLOT QUESTION

Shall the Ozark Fire Protection District issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of Twelve Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$12,500,000) for the purpose of acquiring real property, constructing, renovating, improving, equipping and furnishing fire stations, a training center, and related facilities, purchasing, replacing or repairing vehicles, emergency medical and rescue equipment, fire protection and fire fighting apparatus and auxiliary equipment, and refunding outstanding lease obligations of the District?
